ANDRA DRAG RACING SERIES

As you are no doubt aware, we are hosting the ANDRA Drag Racing Series from 16-17 August. As this is a national event featuring Top Alcohol and Top Bike there are a number of things that we are changing to accommodate the event. We also welcome a number of teams that are travelling from WA who are competing in Modified Bike, Top Sportsman and Outlaws for this event.

SCRUTINEERING LOCATION

As we need to introduce weight testing for Group 1 at the ANDRA event the scrutineering bay will be relocated to Pit bay 1/2 with scales based on the track side of the shed for teams to be able to tow through and get weighed.

PIT ALLOCATIONS

We are working towards numbered pit allocations for this event so everyone knows exactly where to park. This will be dependent on working bees to help map out the pit area in coming weeks. Group 1 teams will fill the available pit garages which will also see containers and transporters located behind the garages in the same style as you would see at V8 Supercar events.

We will be arranging a couple of 20kVA generators to provide power around the general pit area to assist teams that would normally be based in the garages.

SHADE PEGS

Please remember that you are not allowed to use tent pegs in the bitumen paddock area as this damages the surface. If you need to secure your shades please ensure you use suitable weights as an alternative.

After receiving feedback at recent events we could see the difficulty of conducting presentations without any form of trophy or recognition for your efforts. While it was always the intent to provide trophies at major events such as the NT Titles we will be re-introducing trophies to all Track Championship events starting from Round 4 in early August. trophies will once again be available for you to put on display.

CREW PARKING

As we reminded teams during the NT Titles, there are a number of crew that are parking in the pit area which is in turn causing issues for fellow racers. Please remember that non-essential trailers and ALL crew cars (other than designated tow vehicles which should have your race number and bracket written on the front window) should be parked along the back fence of the pit area. Thank you to those who did move their vehicles on Saturday night, it was greatly appreciated.

2014 RACE SEASON

As we have mentioned at recent drivers briefings the NT Government is commencing upgrades to the overall Hidden Valley Motorsport Complex in 2014. A media release from the NT Government in May 2013 stated more than \$5 million has been allocated for Hidden Valley in the 2013-14 Budget for resurfacing the V8 track circuit (2.9km) and upgrading V8 concrete barriers to meet the national

standards required to host national and regional motor sporting events

An additional \$4.12 million will be provided in 2014-15 to upgrade sewerage, toilet blocks and drainage and redesign Turn One of the Hidden Valley circuit.

This is at a very early stage with the Government so it is unclear what impacts it may have on our racing season. Preliminary discussion suggests it could be scheduled between June and September 2014. As we find out more we will keep you in the loop.

ANDRA CHANGES TO STREET CARS

The Australian National Drag Racing Association is set to make big changes to its rules for street cars, with modern 'street registered' vehicles being permitted to run without roll cages down to a limit of 10.00 seconds for the first time.

Under the new safety rules, vehicles manufactured post January 1, 2008 will be able to run as quick as 10.00 seconds and as fast as 140mph (225.30kph) (whichever is the lesser) for the quarter mile without a roll cage. For the full report click here

PIT SPEAKERS

For those that may not be aware, there is an individual speaker in each pit garage. These have individual volumes so don't forget to check it out at the start of each event as they may be turned down and you could miss important PA calls.

ANDRA VOLUNTARY CREW

The system of voluntary ANDRA crew membership has now been formalised across all tracks and provides a new option for crew members to avoid lengthy queues for signing an indemnity.

Crew membership is available for just \$44 a year and includes all the benefits of ANDRA associate membership such as the current ANDRA rulebook plus new rulebooks if















the membership is still current, the quarterly ANDRA Fastlane magazine, two ANDRA stickers and an ANDRA membership card. You will also get a free divisional drag racing licence for vehicles 11.00 seconds and slower where applicable along with Category 2 ANDRA Personal Accident Cover at off-street meetings.

In addition, ANDRA crew membership allows the holder to sign an annual indemnity which means they are no longer required to sign in for an arm band at each event. Instead a clear pouch containing your blue membership card and event ticket must be worn whenever in 'hot' areas (those areas where an indemnity must be signed to have access) at the track.
