



Restricted Areas Policy

Definition of the Restricted Area

The Restricted area defined in this policy is the area considered as the staging area, from the gate leading the pit area into the staging lanes, across to the outer edge of the V8 Supercar main straight, and up to the Drag Strip Control Tower.

Definition of the Priority Restricted Area

The Priority Restricted area defined in this policy is the area considered as the Pre-Staging area, water burnout area, the startline area, including the viewing area between the concrete barriers, and the area located between the spectator fences and the walls on each side of the racetrack.

Restricted Areas - Indemnity Statement

All persons with access to the Restricted Areas must read, accept and sign the ANDRA Indemnity Statement and display the relevant armband at all times. Unauthorised persons will not be permitted into any Restricted Areas.

Priority Restricted Area - Competitor / Crew Access

Competitors / Crew issued with an armband and who have signed the ANDRA indemnity are permitted into the Priority Restricted area only when their vehicle is racing.

* **Please Note:** Priority Crew Access to the startline is only available for short periods only.

Priority Restricted Area - Competitor / Crew Member Viewing Area

Competitors / Crew issued with an armband and who have signed the ANDRA indemnity are permitted between the concrete barriers at the start line on a limited basis.

No competitor or crew is to remain in this area for long periods.

No competitor or crew must be in front of the Starter.

Competitor or crew may be asked to move by officials if the area becomes congested.

Smoking in Priority Restricted Area

Smoking is banned in the Priority Restricted Area
